

Tears of joy were shed as our 8 graduating 4th graders ran through a gauntlet of the other kids and tutors as we clapped and screamed as they left us for new schools next year. Our hopes, dreams and prayers are with this group, some of whom started just as Covid was winding down. They leave a legacy of hard work, vastly improved reading skills, and joy-filled attitudes with a love of reading.

The academic results are in from the Whiz Kids office, informing us that we had a remarkable year. 19 of our students improved their reading scores, and 13 students improved by more than 15 points! These are amazing results and are directly tied to the dedication, consistency, and love shown by our tutors, and by the warm, safe, and welcoming environment provided by Trina and other members of Crown Heights UMC. Our site also provided our kids with many special events like the Christmas banquet, outside field trips to the Belle Isle Library, Full Circle Bookstore, the Contemporary Art Museum and Dynamo Gym. The kids responded with excellent behavior and smiles.
